Benjamin BALET wrote:

> uninstall/reinstall AMC doesn't restore a default configuration.

There is no need to reinstall AMC to restore the default configuration. You can restore it by deleting the @cf.default.xml@ and @state.xml@ files present in the *.AMC.d* folder in your home directory.

After deleting these files start AMC. It will open with the default configuration.

The whole configuration is not reset while uninstalling/reinstalling AMC as the *.AMC.d* folder, which stores the user preferences, is not removed during uninstallation .
