<b>Description:</b>	It can be interesting to use a default scoring strategy using @formula@, such as @\baremeDefautM{formula=NBC-NMC}@. However, it should be possible to cancel this default strategy with @\scoring{formula=}@ to use a different strategy locally for a few questions. This does not work, as @\scoring{formula=}@ sets @formula@ to an empty value, leading to null scores.
