In particular, you see the question-id and the correctchoice boxes ticked.</p> <p>It would be nice if the scoring value for each choice would also be available, in particular for those cases where a wrong choice still delivers points.</p> <p>It would be sufficient to let the scoring command have a silent (exam mode) and a verbose mode (in catalogue/answers mode) and print the information on the spot where the scoring value is given. This is typically at the beginning of the question or questionmult of after a choice with a \scoring value.</p>
