Description:	<p>I had some problems with AMC today and it took me quite some time to figure out that the comment package is not working properly.</p> <p>Replicate:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Create new project from templates (I used the EN separate answer sheets)2. Update documents, works fine (as intended)3. Edit source, add <code>\usepackage{comment}</code> in one of the first lines (I used 5) and add <code>\begin{comment}test\end{comment}</code> to the <code>\onecopy</code> or <code>\begin{examcopy}</code> content, I added it to line 534. Update documents, get multiple errors and it doesn't compile properly and thus one can't use AMC as long as this environment is used. <p>The error (once for each created copy):</p> <p>ERR>Paragraph ended before \xComment was complete.</p> <p>ERR>Extra }, or forgotten \endgroup.</p> <p>Tested under version 1.3.0+hg2016-03-21 (checked out from bitbucket and compiled) and the most recent version compiled from source.</p>
