In both cases the auto-multiple-choice file at /usr/bin has the line</p> <pre>\$mods_dir="/usr/lib/AMC";</pre> <p>It should be</p> <pre>\$mods_dir="/usr/lib64/AMC";</pre> <p>There is no AMC directory under /usr/lib.</p>

When building AMC, you should set @MODSDIR@ to the desired value in @Makefile.conf@, or create a specific @Makefile-OpenSuse.conf@ with adapted configuration values, and use

```
make AMCCONF=OpenSuse
```
